

IMPORTANT NOTICE OF PLAN CHANGE



Effective August 1, 2026, the NECA-IBEW Welfare Trust Fund will expand coverage for 90-day supplies of maintenance medications to all MedImpact participating network pharmacies. This update gives Participants and Dependents more flexibility in where they fill eligible long-term prescriptions.

What is Changing

- **Current rule:** Maintenance prescriptions are covered for up to three 34-day retail fills (or fewer). After that, they must be filled as a 90-day supply through MedImpact mail order or a CVS retail pharmacy.
- **Beginning August 1, 2026:** Eligible 90-day maintenance prescriptions may be filled at any MedImpact participating network retail pharmacy.
- **No cost changes:** Deductibles and copay amounts will remain the same.

How to Find a Network Pharmacy

To locate a MedImpact participating network retail pharmacy:

1. Sign in to your MedImpact account at www.medimpact.com.
2. Select "Pharmacy Search."
3. Enter your location to view network pharmacies in your area.

Most pharmacies participate in the MedImpact network. If you need help, call MedImpact Customer Service at 888-807-5745.

If You Want to Change Pharmacies

After August 1, 2026, if you would like to move your 90-day maintenance prescription(s) to a different pharmacy, contact your prescriber and ask them to send the prescription(s) to the MedImpact network pharmacy you choose.

If you prefer to keep getting your 90-day maintenance prescription(s) at your current pharmacy, no action is needed.

NOTE: This change affects Participants and Dependents covered under active and pre-65 retiree plans, including the under-65 spouses and dependents of over-65 retirees. This change DOES NOT APPLY TO Medicare-eligible retirees (Over age 65 and Medicare eligible due to disability) and their Medicare-eligible dependents who participate in the VibrantRx™ prescription drug plan sponsored by the Fund. (Such retirees already have the option to receive 90-day supplies of maintenance drugs through any any network pharmacy.)
